We Gave Away 31,000 Pounds of Pet Supplies This Morning
No rescue pet needs to miss Thanksgiving dinner.

Encinitas, CA – **Twenty Six pallets of pet food and other supplies were distributed to non-profit rescue groups this morning at your Rancho Coastal Humane Society (RCHS) at 389 Requeza Street in Encinitas. The supplies were loaded in less than one hour into 37 vehicles. This Thanksgiving Dinner and other products from Chewy were donated through Rescue Bank ® operated by Greater Good Charities, a non-profit organization that supports animal rescue and rehabilitation groups by providing services and supplies.**

This food donation also included products ranging from cat litter and leashes to bird seed, horse food, and pet enclosures.

Thanks to Rescue Bank, there was no cost to the rescues for the supplies or shipping. RCHS distributed the food to 501 (c) (3) non-profit pet rescue groups.

RCHS spokesman John Van Zante says, “This is a highly organized effort. The rescues provide their names and non-profit I.D. numbers. When they pull into the parking lot our team loads them up and they never even get out of their vehicles. **This morning our team loaded an average of 567 pounds of food per minute on behalf of Greater Good Charities and Rescue Bank.**”

While the food this morning was distributed to non-profit rescues, your Rancho Coastal Humane Society is also conducting a “Thanks Giving-Back” Pet Food Drive.

The public is encouraged to drop off donations at Rancho Coastal Humane Society at 389 Requeza Street in Encinitas through this Saturday..

Supplies will be distributed on Sunday, November 22nd from 10 AM to 1 PM at Kamp Kanine, located at the entrance to Rancho Coastal Humane Society.
